**RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 31-2020 ADOPTED  
ON JANUARY 21, 2020**

**WHEREAS**, the Governor’s Council on Alcoholism and Drug Abuse established the Municipal Alliances for the Prevention of Alcoholism and Drug Abuse in 1989 to educate and engage residents, local government and law enforcement officials, schools, nonprofit organizations, the faith community, parents youth and other allies in efforts to prevent alcoholism and drug abuse in communities throughout New Jersey; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Commissioners of the City of Millville, County of Cumberland, State of New Jersey recognizes that the abuse of alcohol and drugs is a serious problem in our society amongst persons of all ages; and therefore has an established Municipal Alliance Committee; and,

**WHEREAS**, the City of Millville further recognizes that it is incumbent upon not only public officials but upon the entire community to take action to prevent such abuses in our community; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Millville has applied for funding to the Governor’s Council on Alcoholism and Drug Abuse through the County of Cumberland; and

**WHEREAS**, due to the significant decrease in Drug Enforcement Demand Reduction (DEDR) Fund collections in Fiscal Year 2020 the Governor’s Council on Alcoholism and Drug Abuse has announced a reduction to the previously awarded county grants for Fiscal Year 2021.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Millville, County of Cumberland and State of New Jersey hereby recognizes the following:

- 1. The City of Millville does hereby authorize submission of a strategic plan for the Millville Municipal Alliance Grant for fiscal year 2021 grant period of October 1, 2020 to June 30, 2021 in the reduced amount of:

Cash Match	\$ <u>2,791.00</u>
In-Kind	\$ <u>8,373.00</u>
